Ntsiki Magwaza, spokeswoman for Water and Sanitation said that "huge efforts" had ensured that nobody was unduly inconvenienced, especially over the current holiday period.

"We actually managed to complete the work and restore normal water supply a few days ahead of the stipulated time," she said.
