

## UMGENI WATER CLASSROOMS

Umgeni Water has three water classrooms which are built on - site. The advantage of having water classrooms at the sites is that learners get to tour the works once they have had the classroom presentations. In the water classroom, learners get exposed to an interactive learning process which makes use of group discussions, support learning materials like charts, brochures and activity sheets. All water classrooms are equipped with audio-visual material which enhances the learning process.

The water classroom presentations expose learners to issues covering some or most of the following aspects:

- ✘ an overview on water
- ✘ water cycle
- ✘ water pollution
- ✘ health and hygiene
- ✘ water borne diseases
- ✘ the water treatment processes
- ✘ conservation tips

Water classrooms are situated at the following sites:

### **Durban Heights**

The water classroom is situated at the Durban Heights Water Works which is in Westville (Reservoir Hills). This classroom accommodates 35 seated learners. Learners get full exposure to the water purification process.

### **Darvill**

This water classroom accommodates 50 seated learners. It is situated at Darvill Waste Water Works which is on New England Road in Pietermaritzburg. The tour highlights all the aspects involved in the waste water treatment process.

### **Midmar**

The water classroom is situated at the Midmar Water Works in Howick and accommodates 35 seated learners. Various stages of the water purification process are explained to the learners.
