PIPE SUPPLY & CONSTRUCTION OF A 13km LONG DN1100 BULK WATER MAIN FROM RICHMOND OFF-TAKE TO UMLAAS ROAD

Umgeni Water is a state owned business enterprise that operates within the South African legislative parameters of the Water Services Act, Act 108 of 1997, PFMA 1 of 1999 and Public Audit Act of 2004. In terms of the PFMA, the Minister of the Department of Water Affairs is the executive authority. The primary function of Umgeni Water is to supply treated water in bulk to its municipal customers.

Competent and experienced contractors who are registered prior to evaluation on a CIDB grading equal to or higher than 9 CE are hereby invited to tender for the supply of coated and lined steel pipes and the construction of a 13 000m long bulk water main between the Richmond Off-Take in the Edendale area of Pietermaritzburg and Umlaas Road in KwaZulu Natal.

Only Tenderers who are registered with CIDB grading higher or equal to 9 CE prior to tender evaluation are eligible to tender.

Evaluation criteria: SANS Method 2 (Price and Preference) . 90/10 point scoring system as per PPPFA.
