## NOTICE & INVITATION TO PRE-QUALIFY

### Provision of Office Cleaning, Health & Hygiene Services at various Umgeni Water Sites

Umgeni Water is a state owned business enterprise that operates within the South African legislative parameters of the Water Services Act, Act 108 of 1997, PFMA 1 of 1999 and Public Audit Act of 2004. The organisation is directly accountable to the Department of Water Affairs and Forestry. The primary function of Umgeni Water is to supply treated water in bulk to its municipal customers. Competent service providers are invited to collect pre-qualification questionnaires for the above services at various Umgeni Water sites.
